The campus placements have become the 'Program Outcome (PO)'.

The new era will be the journey from **MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses)** to MOOOs (Massive Open Online Opportunities). In this new model, the large IT companies invite applications online open to all AICTE-approved institutions, offering the opportunity even to isolated towns but connected to internet. Students can take up an online test remotely, thereafter, they are invited to a nearby company office location/college for a face-to-face interview and successful candidates are offered a job.

At KIET, we have deeply analysed the science, psychology and fiction of campus placement and built a sustainable 'Vertical & Horizontal (V&H) Placement Model'. Today we have a basket of dream recruiters like Amazon, Flipkart, Walmart, Mercedes Benz, American Express, Cisco, Adani and many more along with IT9avratnas. Every year, 300+ companies conduct campus recruitment and generate 1500+ job offers with the highest CTC of Rs. 48.89 LPA; Average CTC of Rs. 7.25 LPA & achieving 95% placements.

## Promoting Hindi Language in B.Tech Curriculum

India is on its way to become the thirdlargest economy by 2027 and targeting to enter the list of developed countries by 2047. But according to a recent report by **Nasscom-Zinnov**, India is projected to face a shortage of 14-19 lakh tech professionals by 2026. Now, the question is "What is barring us to generate engineering professionals? How can we surpass the barrier(s)?"

When we talk about engineering or technical curriculum, it is mostly in English. Think about students coming from rural and underprivileged backgrounds. Despite their talent, they are usually left out because they are not good with English. Resulting, the nation is lagging to meet the demand for skilled

professionals.

It is the right time to promote the study of these courses in the language of the students' choice. If we compare with countries like Japan, Spain, China, etc., they prefer to develop talent and skills in their own native language. These countries have pretty well utilized the talent of both, students who are good with English and those who are not pretty comfortable with English.

We should understand that English is just a language and nothing more than communication medium. Keeping this in mind, **Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU), Lucknow** is going to introduce B.Tech courses in Hindi without interfering the existing curriculum. It's really a great initiative taken by the state university.

With the initiatives like "Make in India" and "Atmanirbhar Bharat" where companies are encouraged to develop and manufacture products in India and are incentivized with dedicated investments into manufacturing, companies will be able to leverage the untapped pool of skilled professionals once the language barrier is removed.

It's not an END, it's just a start, a blessing for the students coming from rural or underprivileged backgrounds.
