

Skill Development Opportunities for faculties

The technology and capabilities required for Industry 4.0 and research advancements are dynamic, both students and teachers must keep up to speed. Faculty competencies relating to advanced research and mezzanine technologies need to be updated to meet current demand. Lifelong learning is essential, and teachers should keep up with students to guide them through projects and internships. Faculty will be able to construct advanced curriculum and state-of-the-art research laboratories if technical and academic competencies are regularly updated.

For the first time, AICTE presents a comprehensive **360-degree feedback mechanism** as a measure of performance for faculty's career advancement. The 360-degree feedback approach is in line with the **NEP 2020** goal of improving technical education quality. According to the Gazette of India, March 2019, it has been made necessary for faculty career development.

The primary goal of KIET is to equip faculty with the chance to bridge the industrial and academic gap by training them in Mezzanine technologies. Create and implement training and development programs for teachers on strategically important competencies, as well as establish links with industry. KIET has a tradition of planning and organizing diverse training programs for both students and faculties. Following the identification of the requirements, targeted training programs are organized. Internships are organized in addition to training and development activities. MOOCs, online/offline training, labs, and certificates will be included in the instruction. For both faculty and students, **KIET has provided MOOC** courses on Edx and Coursera.
