Augmentation of skill is the utmost important factor in current scenario and plays a key role in economic progress and social development. There is already a significant gap between academia and industry requirements. One of the most cut-throat industries in the world is the pharmaceutical industry in India. It is essential to recognize and address its skilling issues. In the last few years, the pool of employable talent in the pharmaceutical industry has shrunk. According to a study on the skill gap undertaken by the National Skill **Development Cooperation** between 2010 and 2014, there would be a great need for trained workers in 24 important industries by 2023. In the pharmaceutical industry, there were 1.86 million employees in 2013, and by 2023, that

number is projected to rise to 3.6 million. Following steps would help to address this issue:

- **Developing Industry Employability Skills:** To ensure that new hires are more prepared and competent from the beginning, a paradigm shift from a "supply stipulated" system to a "demand determined" model may be necessary.
- Total Quality Management (TQM): By including an expert in the organization at every level, TQM method will help to boost an organization's effectiveness.
- Innovation Ecosystem: Innovation Ecosystem comprises of three nodes: -Node 1: Inspire or Invest; Node 2: Invent or Innovate; **Node 3:** Incubate or Market
- Developing Modules and Curriculum Based on Skill Development: It affects learners' behavior and relationships with others in four areas: Cognitive, Affective, Interpersonal, and Psychomotor skills.
- Issue-Based Education: It is a teaching approach that emphasizes self-directed learning, discussion in small groups with facilitators, and issues with knowledge acquisition.
