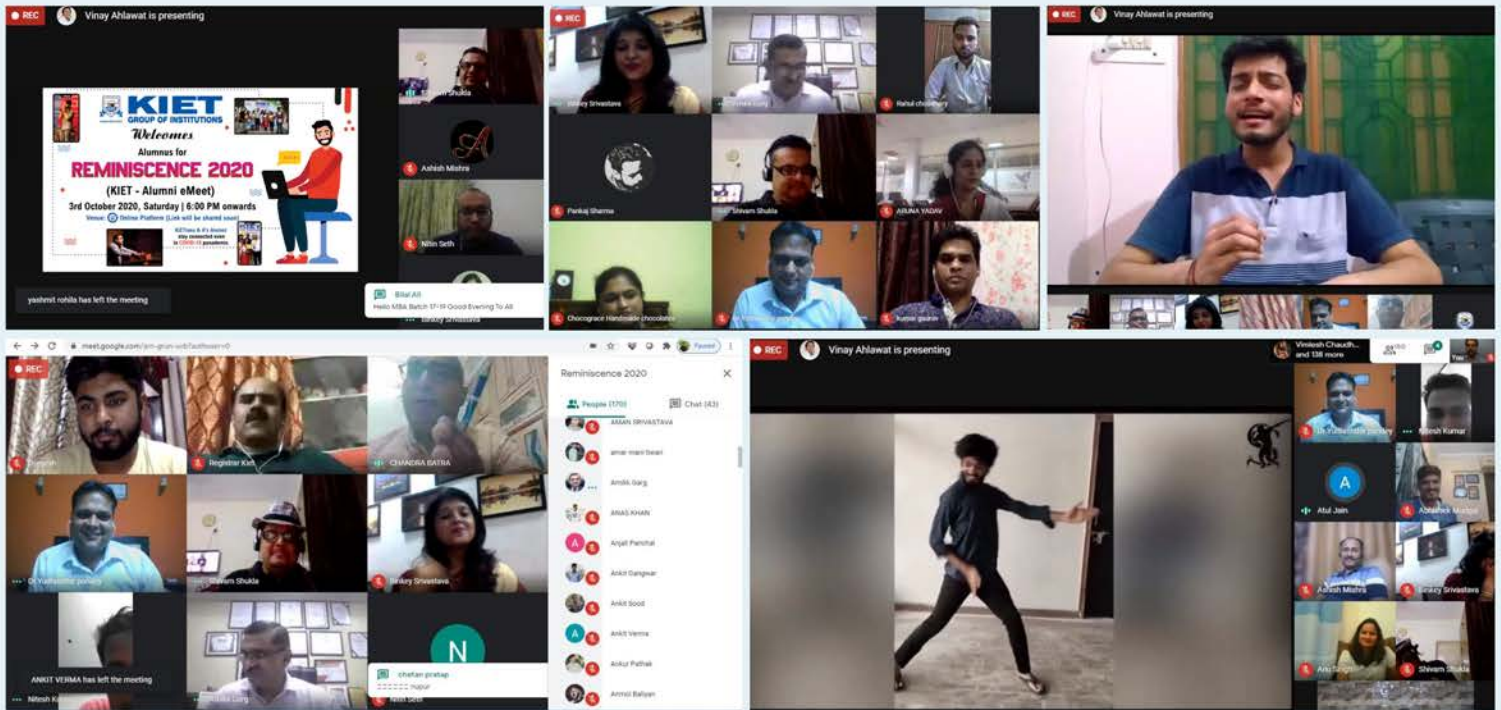
<< CELEBRATION @ KIET >>

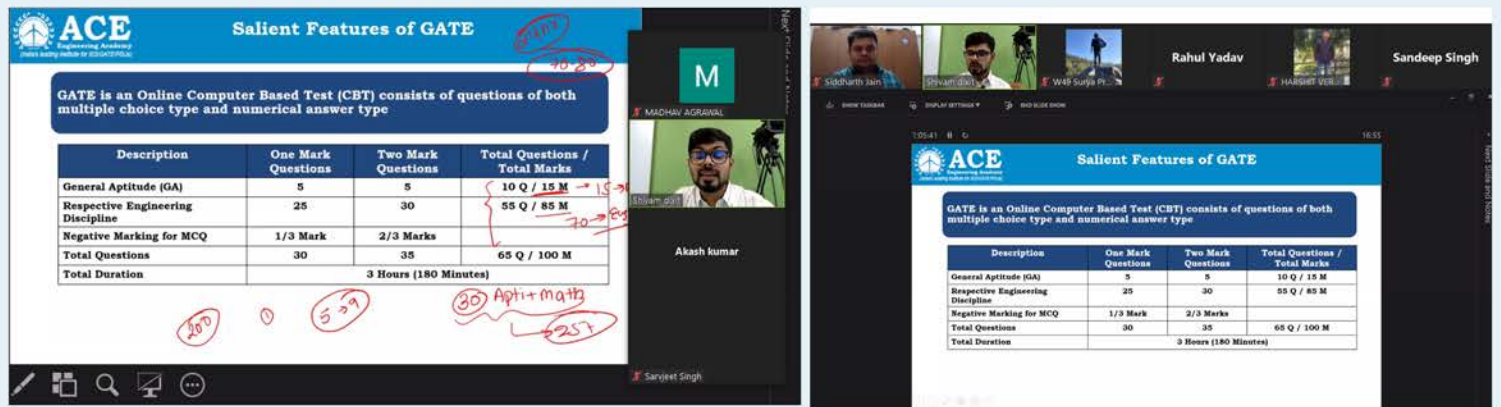

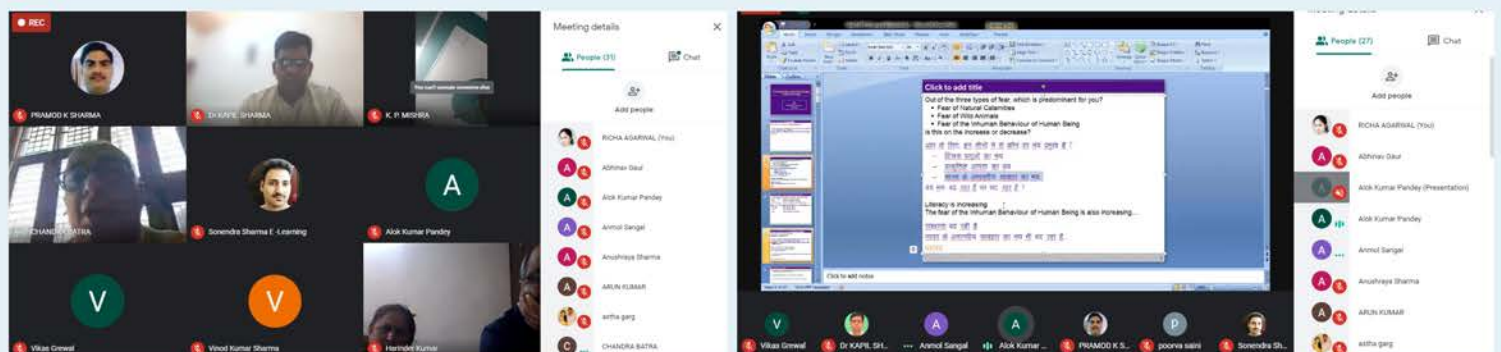
