The campus provides appropriate living environment that encourages interaction and camaraderie. Our students are innovators, engineers, managers, entrepreneurs, and aspiring leaders.

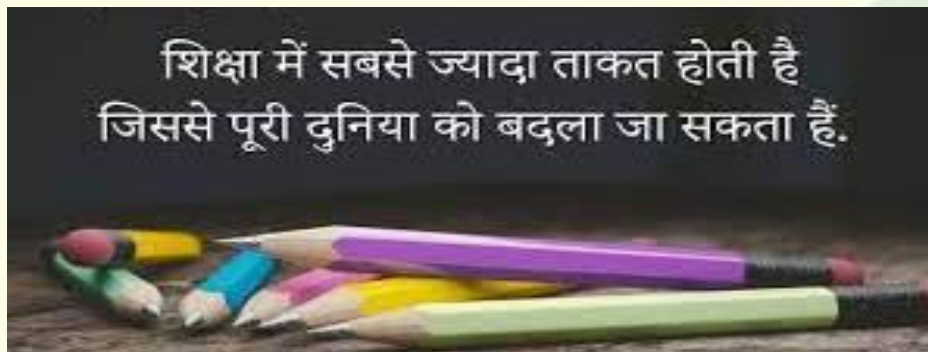

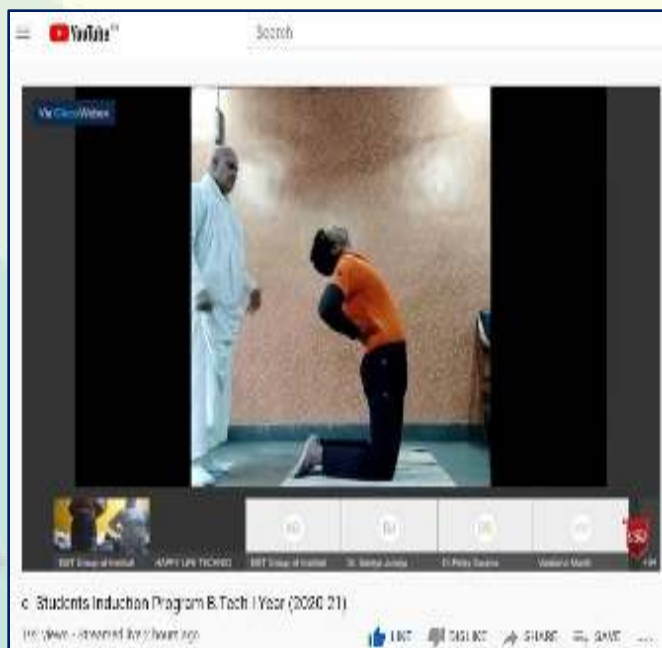
SESSION BY MR. BHAVESH PANDE
