

I. Disbursement of funds to University/Institutions

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

As you are aware, there is a critical need to train teachers in effective of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in education and in the online blended/hybrid teaching-learning process. To meet this urgent requirement, IIT Bombay has designed Faculty Development Program (FDP), which has been approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). In our first FDP initiative, we offered a single Four-week long programme, which was attended by about 4000 teachers, of which 2193 qualified.

We are glad to announce that under the aegis of Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission for Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT), MHRD, GoI, we will be conducting two separate FDPs which are as follows:




