

A workshop on 'Enhancing Technical skills for Research, Review and Patent writing' was organized by KIET School of Pharmacy, Ghaziabad on 15th February'2019 at KSOP Auditorium from 1:30p.m. onwards. Total 65 participants including the students of B.Pharm, M.Pharm and faculties from various departments of KIET Group of Institutions attended the workshop.

The programme started with the welcome speech of Dr. Jagannath Sahoo, Principal, KIET School of Pharmacy. He welcomed the participants and the guest speaker, Ms. Puja Kumar – an expert in patent filing. In his welcome speech he emphasized on the importance of 'Publish or Perish'.

Ms. Puja Kumar began her lecture by a video describing the importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR). Then she continued by elaborating that Patent is a legal right, a monopoly right given by the government for twenty years for a novelty that has some inventive step and has a industrial utilization. As most of the listeners were of Pharmacy field, the speaker emphasized on the patents in Pharmaceuticals like the list of patents in Pharma field, the types of patents-formulations, composition, combinations, diagnostic kits and designs of medical devices. Ms. Puja Kumar also made the participants aware of the procedure for patent filing filing an application, publication, pre-grant opposition, examination, patent acceptance grant of patent, post grant opposition; types of patent applications – ordinary patent application, patent of addition. International application by Patent Corporation Treaty (PCT), divisional application and the documents required. The speaker also discussed about drafting the patent – title, objectives of specification, kinds of specifications, elements of specifications, claims and case study. The most interesting part of her lecture was that she told how the students can opt for their carcer in IPR and she also solved the queries of the participants. The speaker was really successful in creating the awareness about the significance of patent and in capturing the attention of all the participants irrespective of their streams and age group.

The guest speaker's lecture was followed by the presentation of Dr. Jagannath Sahoo, Principal, KSOP on Guidelines for writing a Review Article. Dr. Sahoo started with a saying of Woodrow Wilson – 'I not only use all the brains that I have, but all that I can borrow' continuing by emphasizing on the types and importance of publications. IIe also described the parts of a review article – Title, abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusion. 


