A workshop on 'Enhancing Technical skills for Research, Review and Patent writing' was organized by KIET School of Pharmacy, Ghaziabad on 15<sup>th</sup> February'2019 at KSOP Auditorium from 1:30p.m. onwards. Total 65 participants including the students of B.Pharm, M.Pharm and faculties from various departments of KIET Group of Institutions attended the workshop.

The programme started with the welcome speech of Dr. Jagannath Sahoo, Principal, KIET School of Pharmacy. He welcomed the participants and the guest speaker, Ms. Puja Kumar – an expert in patent filing. In his welcome speech he emphasized on the importance of 'Publish or Perish'.

Ms. Puja Kumar began her lecture by a video describing the importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR). Then she continued by elaborating that Patent is a legal right, a monopoly right given by the government for twenty years for a novelty that has some inventive step and has a industrial utilization. As most of the listeners were of Pharmacy field, the speaker emphasized on the patents in Pharmaceuticals like the list of patents in Pharma field, the types of patents-formulations, composition, combinations, diagnostic kits and designs of medical devices. He also described the parts of a review article – Title, abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusion. 


