RULES AND REGULATIONS

Note: Each student can only participate in maximum of two Games.

FOOTBALL

- 1. Every team can have maximum of 15 players (11+4) for **boys** and maximum of 9 players (6+3) for **girls**.
- 2. Each team must have players from their respective hostel with maximum of 7 players from any year.
- 3. The duration of the game will 15-3-15 (for boys) and 10-5-10 (for girls).
- 4. The jersey color should be mentioned beforehand and should be strictly followed.
- 5. Shoes and shorts are compulsory.
- 6. The Referee's decision is final and no argument should be done. Else the player or team will be penalized as the referee will think right to do.
- 7. Any misconduct on the field can lead to disqualification of the team.
- 8. Other rules regarding the match will be told on the field.
- 9. The above rules are applicable on both girls and boys football team.
- 10. All players are to honor the game rules and play in healthy competition.
- 11. If the player fails to report the venue 15 minutes before the game, the opponent shall be announced as winner.
- 12. For boys the match will be conducted department wise while for girls it will conducted year wise.

TABLE-TENNIS

- 1. There will the three events in the tournament in both boys and girls Singles, Doubles and Team Event.
- 2. For the events, maximum of 3 teams from each hostel can participate. The no. of players in a team should not be more than 2-3 players for the team event.
- 3. The team event shall comprise of three matches two singles and one doubles. Each match will have three sets of 11 points each.
- 4. For Singles and Doubles, each match will have three or five sets of 11 points each.
- 5. If the player fails to report the venue 15 minutes before the game, the opponent shall be announcing as winner.
- 6. In any case, referee's decision will be final.

BADMINTON

- 1. Maximum 3 Teams from each hostel will be allowed to participate for both boys and girls and in case of more than 3 teams, will play knockout.
- 2. Each team will consist of 4 players only.
- 3. There will be a league tournament.
- 4. The league matches will be of 3 set (15 points each) comprising of two singles match and one doubles match.
- 5. Top two teams from each group will play in semi final round (21 point).
- 6. A mixed Tournament will be there on knockout basis and both participants must be of same hostel.
- 7. All the players are required to be in proper kit and at time (reporting late may lead to disqualification).
- 8. All the players are required to be in non marking shoes only.
- 9. Decision of the Referee will be final.
- 10. If the player/Team fails to report the venue 15 minutes before the game, the opponent shall be announcing as winner.

BASKETBALL

- 1. Each team can have maximum of 5-12 players.
- 2. Rest rules are to be followed according to FIBA.
- 3. There can be a maximum of 2 teams from each hostel.
- 4. The duration of quarters for boys and girls will be 6 minutes only.
- 5. Shorts for boys and for girls either shorts or lower will be permitted.
- 6. Any in-disciplinary action may lead to disqualification; faculty and apex decision will be final.
- 7. Referee decision will be final on court.
- 8. If more than 2 teams come from each hostel then knockout matches will be held among them.
- 9. Other rules will be told on field.
- 10. If the player/Team fails to report the venue 15 minutes before the game, the opponent shall be announcing as winner.

VOLLEYBALL

- 1. Maximum 2 Teams from each hostel will be allowed to participate.
- 2. Each team will consist of minimum 8 players and maximum 12.
- 3. There will be a league tournament.
- 4. The league matches will be of 3 sets (25 each).
- 5. Final match will be of 5 sets (4 sets of 25 points and last set of 15 points).
- 6. All the players are required to be in proper kit and at time (reporting late may lead to disqualification).
- 7. Decision of the Referee will be final.
- 8. Any argument or misbehaviour with Referee as well as players may lead to disqualification of the respective team.
- 9. All players are required to maintain the dignity and respect of the game as well as of other players.
- 10. If the player/Team fails to report the venue 15 minutes before the game, the opponent shall be announcing as winner.

POOL

- 1. There will be a league tournament.
- 2. Each set will be a best of three.
- 3. Break shot will be decided by the toss.
- 4. During break if black ball gets pot than it is considered to be the golden break.
- 5. For a break to be a legal one is required that minimum 4 balls should touch the side cushion.
- 6. For a legal shot any ball after contact with some other ball must touch any of the side cushions.
- 7. Jump and Masse shots are foul.
- 8. Any kind of foul by an opponent will result in ball in hand opportunity for the other opponent.
- 9. Decision of the Referee will be final.
- 10. Any argument or misbehaviour with Referee as well as players may lead to disqualification of the respective team or an individual person.
- 11. All players are required to maintain the dignity and respect of the game as well as of other players.
- 12. If the player/Team fails to report the venue 15 minutes before the game, the opponent shall be announcing as winner.

- Your University/institute/college is requested to confirm its participation in RANN' 2020 on or before 20th February, 2020.
- Every contingent shall be allotted dedicated team liaisons. The contingent leader is required to coordinate with the liaisons on their arrival and throughout the course of the fest.
- Formal Registration of all participating teams will take place before the commencement of the opening Ceremony at the Registration Desk.
- The Contingent Leader of every participating contingent shall receive a copy of the Payment Receipt, General Instructions and Fixtures.
- The Closing Ceremony and the Prize Distribution is scheduled to take place on the 23th of February, 2020 at 6 p.m.
- Event-wise registration is different from Participant/College Registration.
- List of games/sports/events to be organized in RANN' 2020 are provided herein.
- All participants must carry their University/Institute/College ID Cards as the same will be required during registration.
- All participants are required to produce their NOC from their respective College/Institute





CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

- The competitor must exit the circle from the back




